We collect Tuition Fee and the Student Support and Activity Fee which includes ERP, Student ID Card, School Magazine, Local Picnics, Class Photographs, Health Check-up, and School events. Kindly note that Belt and Diaries are not included in the fee.</p> <p><i>Query: There is monopoly in case of the text books and the uniform purchase. Non availability don't get the mentioned books and uniform elsewhere nor do the person who is selling give any discount, MRP being very high.</i></p> <p><i>Response:</i> It is not mandatory to purchase the grey uniform and books from the vendors referred by school. Parents can procure the books from the publishers as per the book list provided by school. However, the sports uniforms are customized according to the groups which must be procured at the address shared by School. Keeping in view, the concerns raised by a few parents we are looking into the change of vendor for the upcoming year.</p> <p><u>Grade: 2</u></p> <p><i>Query: Corrections are not done properly. Checking of note books on time. Incomplete or missing Home Work messages.</i></p> <p><i>Response:</i> The notebooks have been rechecked for mistakes and also for completion before giving them to the students Refer the Handbook for HW Assignments after checking the text messages. However, will ensure that the Homework assignments are given with clarity as per the parent request.</p> <p><i>Query: If the child is absent for a day or two their notes are left incomplete. Required help to complete absent work.</i></p> <p><i>Response:</i> The teachers check the books and support the students in updating the notes missed during their absent period. 	<p>Response: Formative Assessments are conducted as a regular practice to check their conceptual understanding and the teachers to come up with required interventions to clear the misconceptions.</p> <p>Query: Information required on Unit test pattern.</p> <p>Response: Children are tested for concepts. The questioning differs for every test. Sharing the pattern narrows down the scope of answering any kind of question given. We believe in nurturing the children for the development of higher order thinking skills which is the main crux of ICSE approach.</p> <p>Query: Spellings are not orally drilled. Not following phonics pattern.</p> <p>Response: The method of teaching spellings is through phonics and syllabification. However, we shall intensify the practice.</p> <p>Query: The allocation of homework to students lacks consistency. It varies, with assignments sometimes being given for three subjects, and other times, no homework is assigned at all.</p> <p>Response: Homework is given in three subjects every day. Either a written HW or a reading HW is given, unless there have been activities/events/competitions conducted during the subject periods.</p> <p>Query: Hand Writing is not being concentrated by teachers in class work book.</p> <p>Response: Initial days after vacation are challenging and they show gradual and consistent improvement in handwriting. It is the skill which improves with consistency and practice.</p> <p>Grade 4</p> <p>Query: Due to Class high strength, teachers are not able to concentrate on all students. Notes can be upload on portal and some activities cancelled due to various reasons, kindly look into it.</p> <p>Response: Post vacation, it is challenging for the teachers and the students in the initial few weeks and the 'Teaching-Learning Process' gains momentum eventually. 	<p>Query: Provide sports un-chargeable and make it a part of academics. Management has to provide the transport for after school sports if the child utilizes the school bus.</p> <p>Response: PET periods are a part of regular school activities. 'After School Sports' is a facility for professional coaching provided by the school which cannot be included in the regular Time-table. School transport cannot be provided for 'ASS' as the timings nor the logistics support the plying of buses the second time.</p> <p>Query: Regarding holiday assignments. Most of the students incompletely submitted holiday assignments, but still no cross-check further issued certificates to each student.</p> <p>Response: The Holiday HW certificates are given to encourage the prompt submission of completed assignments. However, we will have a thorough check before giving them away to deserving students.</p> <p>Query: Social awareness programs and student/citizen responsibilities toward society to be implemented.</p> <p>Response: Social Awareness programs are a part and parcel of the school activities which are conducted to sensitize the children through Assembly Activities, Circle Time, Student Workshops, Motivational Videos etc to name a few.</p> <p>Query: Students waiting for 10-15minutes to utilize toilets need to resolve.</p> <p>Response: During the short break and the long break, as many children want to use the washroom, it becomes imperative to have the wait time which is not more than 5-10 minutes.</p> <p>Query: Few schools are conducting online classes to cover the syllabus and completing revision, hence requesting to JGS also to conduct online classes in the future during natural calamities.</p> <p>Response: The students have got adjusted to the physical mode which is more conducive for 'Teaching-Learning' and we do not want to revert back unless there is a dire need. We have been considering the challenges like unstable internet connectivity issues and reteach of the lessons taught during the online classes as we do not get full strength in the online classes. The textbooks and notebooks have been given away to the students apart from uploading UT-1 portion in the portal.</p>

	<p>Query: Kids are carrying very heavy backpacks. Considering that kids have to climb multiple flight of stairs, could the school help with reducing the number of books they have to carry each day?</p> <p>Response: For Grade IX and X classes, students are recommended to get their Languages, Mathematics and Social studies text-books to the school. However, for other subjects' students are required to carry only notebooks. Periodic bag checks are also carried on. It has been also suggested to the students sitting together on a bench, one of them can get few text books while other can get the remaining and share the textbooks. The matter will be followed up in particular again.</p> <p>Query: There is too much notes to write leaving very little time for other activities for the kids. For some subjects, writing notes in classwork is the homework. We wanted to raise this issue in case the teachers can find some ways to reduce the "notes burden" on the students.</p> <p>Response: The school emphasizes the importance of taking running notes to improve writing skills. In Grade IX, students may find it challenging initially and completing their notes at home. The students are supposed to complete their notes in the school itself and in that particular subject period only, failing which they are carrying it home to complete it home. This is a trend observed every year and by the end of UT – 1 the students get set with the writing pace. We need to push the children out of their comfort zone to prepare for the upcoming examinations.</p> <p>Query: Multiple deadlines seem to falling at the same time. It is very stressful for kids to complete them. Is it possible for teachers to coordinate their assignments in such a way that there is manageable work each week. Also, the MCQ sheets uploaded to the portal have very short deadlines. If the kids miss seeing the message notification on time, they are getting stressed out with very short time.</p> <p>Response: The Council has added on the MCQs questions in the latest Question paper pattern. Therefore, teachers are preparing the MCQ questions in all the subjects. MCQ worksheets (10 questions in each subject) will be posted weekly to make the students to practice. Would you please consider making these half days leaving 2 and 4 Saturdays as holidays?</i></p> <p><i>Response:</i> Due to unforeseen circumstances, there have been instances when regular school days were affected, leading to a reduction in the total number of instructional days available for the academic year. In order to ensure that our students have ample time to cover the entire syllabus and adequately prepare for their examinations, we have decided to conduct full-day classes on Saturdays till the syllabus is covered at par with the planner. These additional teaching days will help us to bridge the gap caused by the unexpected holidays thus not creating pressure on our students towards the end.</p> <p><i>Query: Request to upload the notes of all subjects in never skip due to child's health issue not regular to school.</i></p> <p><i>Response:</i> The school always has supported the students who have missed the regular schooling due to the medical issues.
