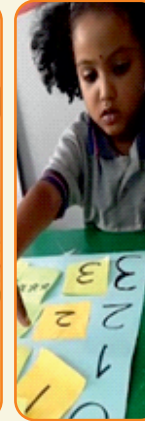
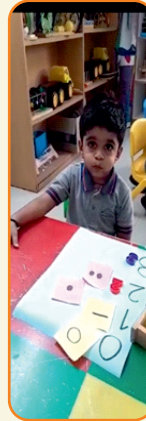
### Stick Figure and Character Representation Activity - Senior KG

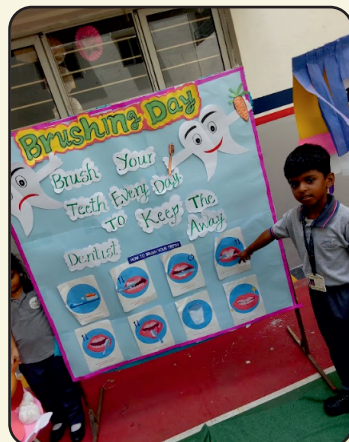


## “Hands-on dental hygiene. Pre-primary students learn effective brushing techniques.”

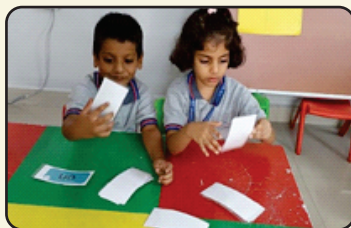
## “Junior KG Celebrates Blue Day with Fun and Learning!”
