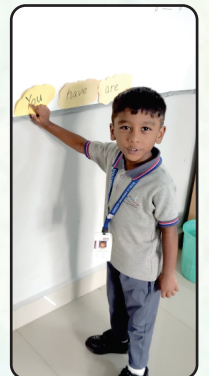
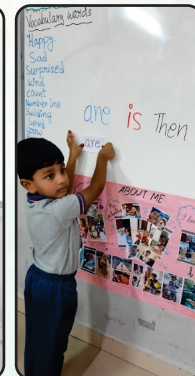
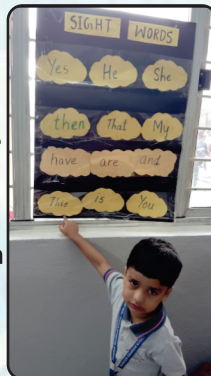
“Exploring Concepts: Junior KG students learnt about inside and outside through fun activities and hands-on experiences!”
