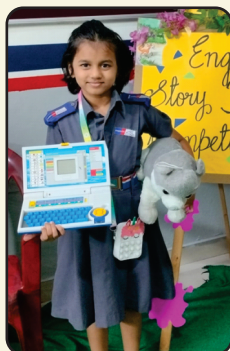
## Successful Parent - Teacher Meeting: Fostering Student Growth:

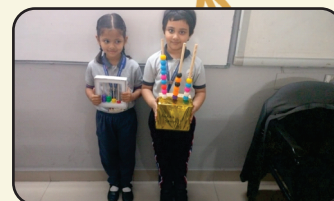
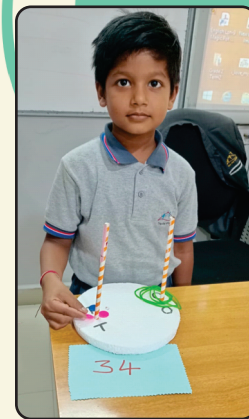
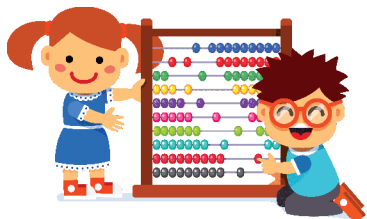
## Imagination in Action: Grades 1 and 2 Storytelling Extravaganza

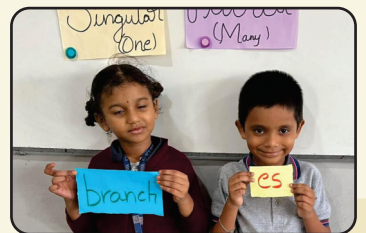
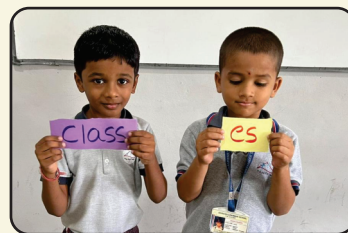


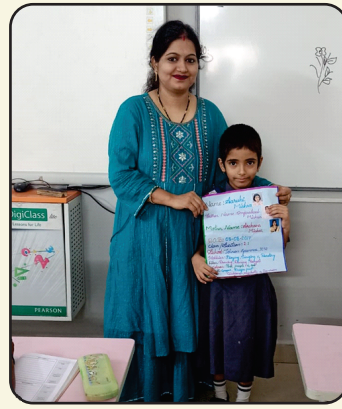
## Tasty Choices: Healthy Food Exploration

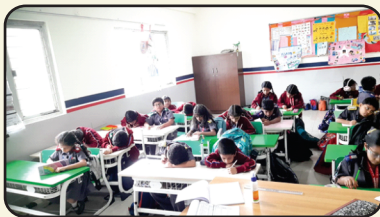
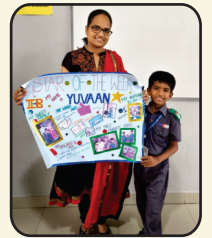
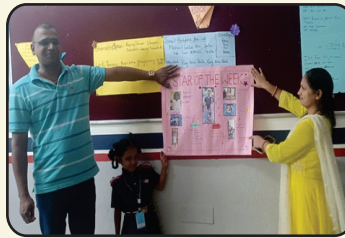
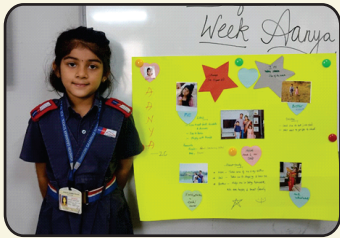




## Star of the Week: A Bright Beginning
