Explore and discover something new...! Club activities of grades 3, 4 and 5

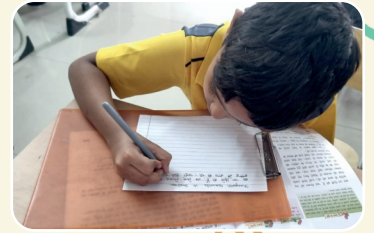
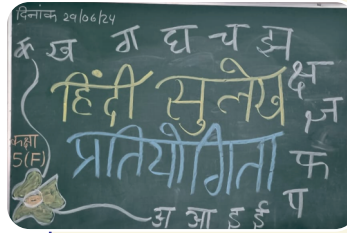

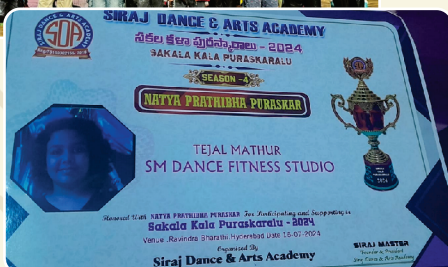
