## The Journey of Artistic Discovery!!!



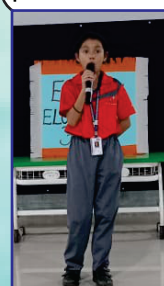

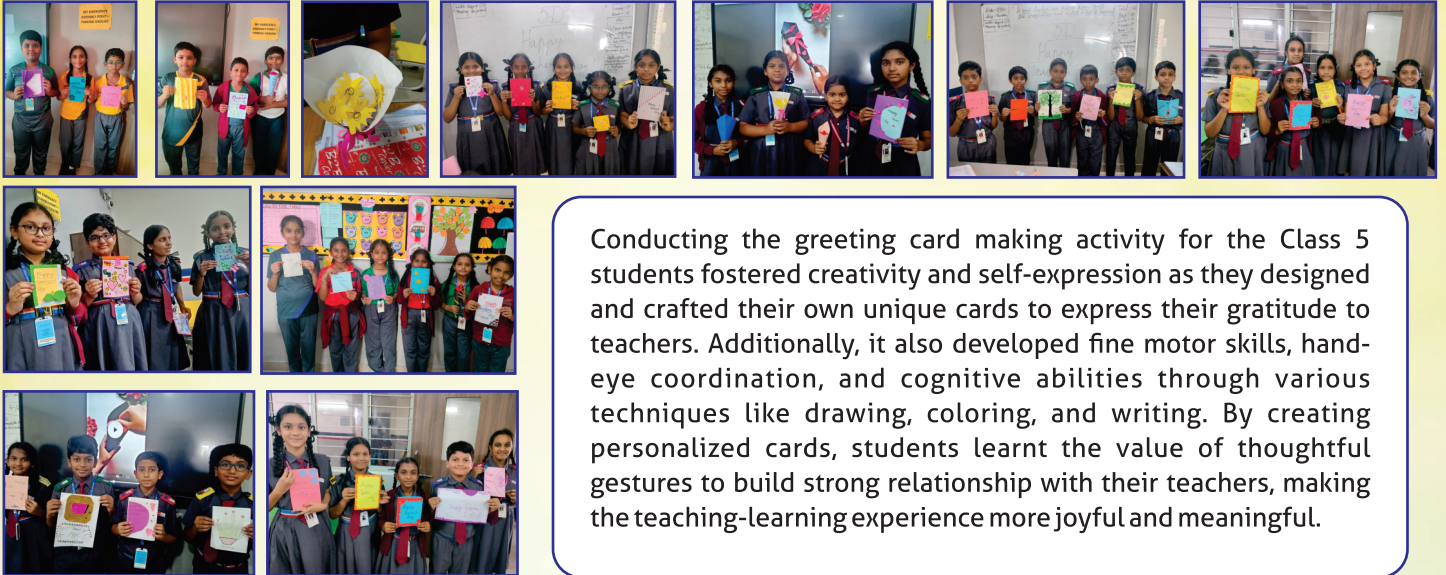
## Elocution competition : Unleashing Young talent

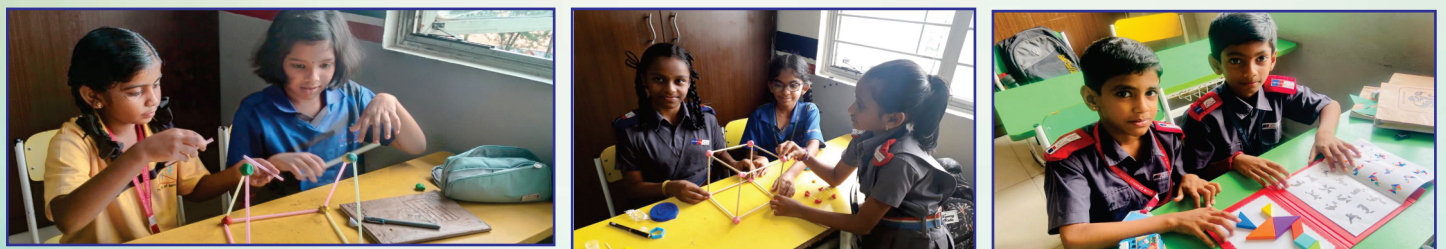
# “Thank you for helping us grow - Happy Teachers' Day!”
