Bonalu Celebration

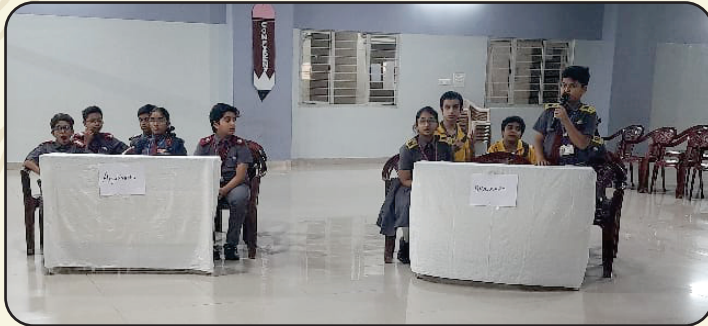

"Spell Bee Finals: A Thrilling Display of Linguistic Mastery"

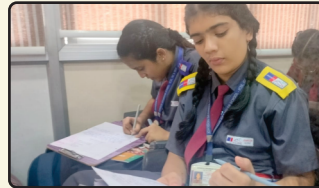

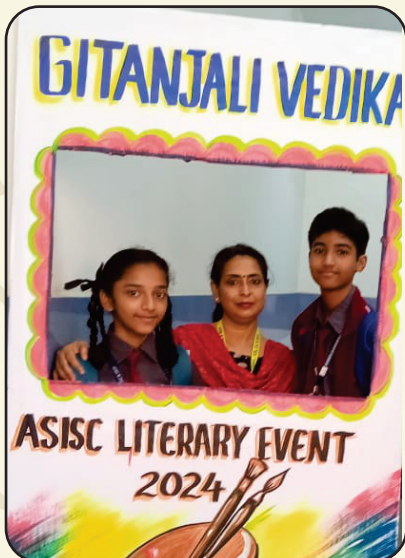
