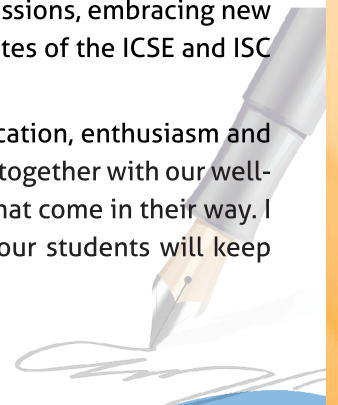

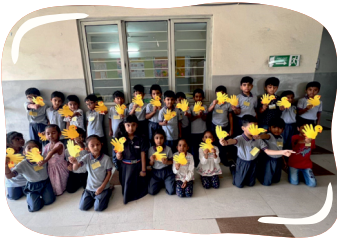

Thanks to the management for this wonderful opportunity.

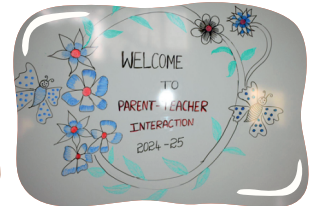
## Parent-Teacher Interaction:

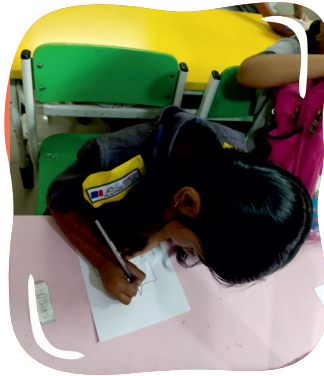

## Phonics and Decoding



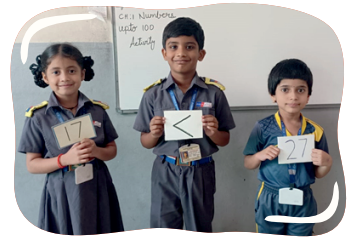
