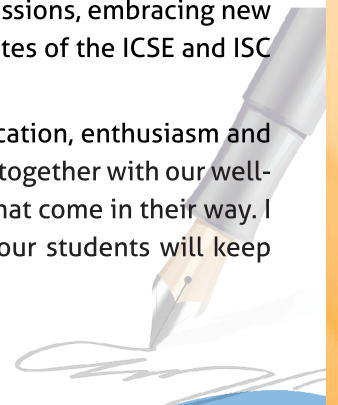

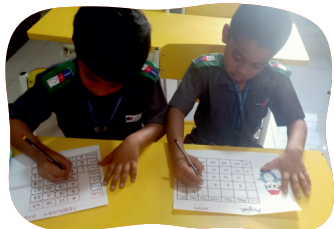
## Social learning with classroom activities

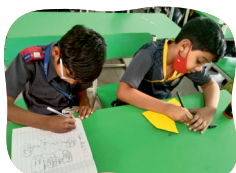
## Learning by doing !!
