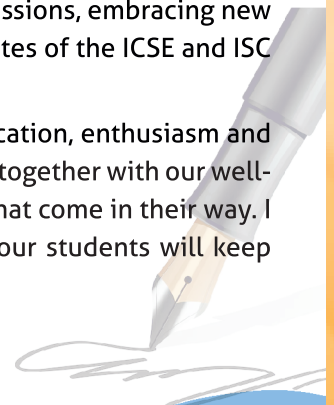

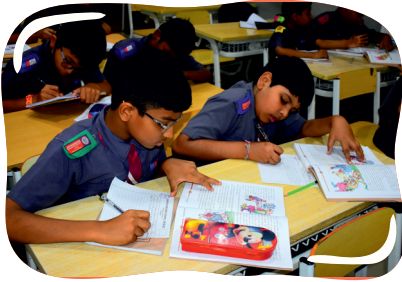
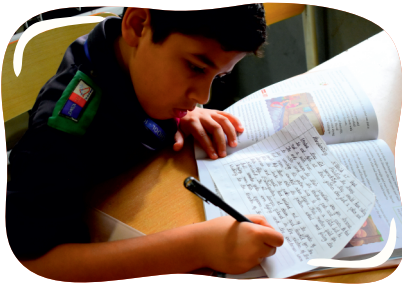
School comes alive with the sounds of laughter, chatter and the occasional squeal of delight.

Nurturing Penmanship: "Handwriting is a reflection of the Soul's Voice."

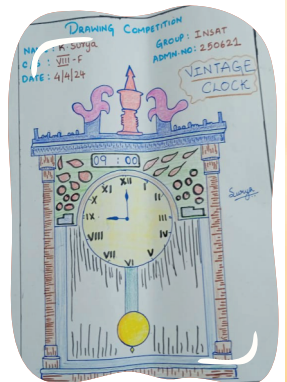


The Handwriting competition in all the three languages was conducted for grades 6 to 8.

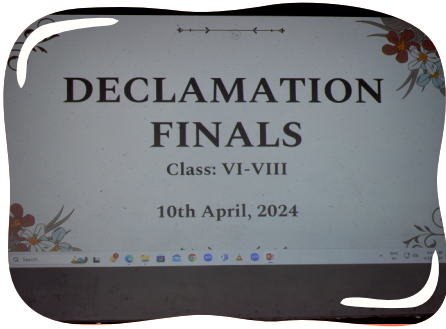
