Ms. K.L. Surekha, Secretary - PTA and Vice Principal, delivered the Vote of Thanks, acknowledging the contribution of all involved.

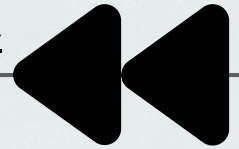
The meeting concluded with the National Anthem, marking the beginning of a new chapter in the educational partnership between the JGS Community and Parent Representatives.

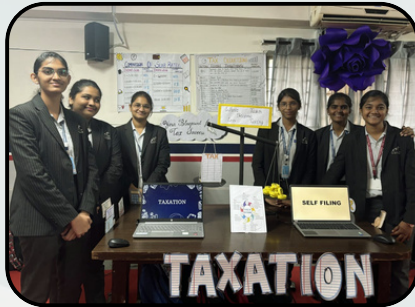


Fantasia Fests

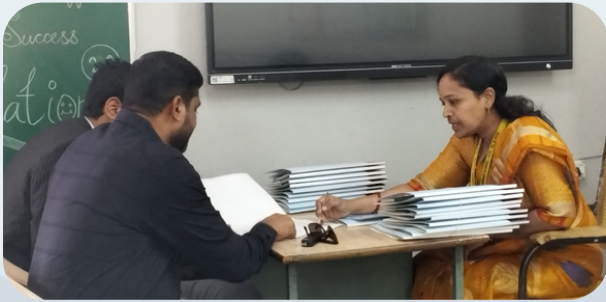
