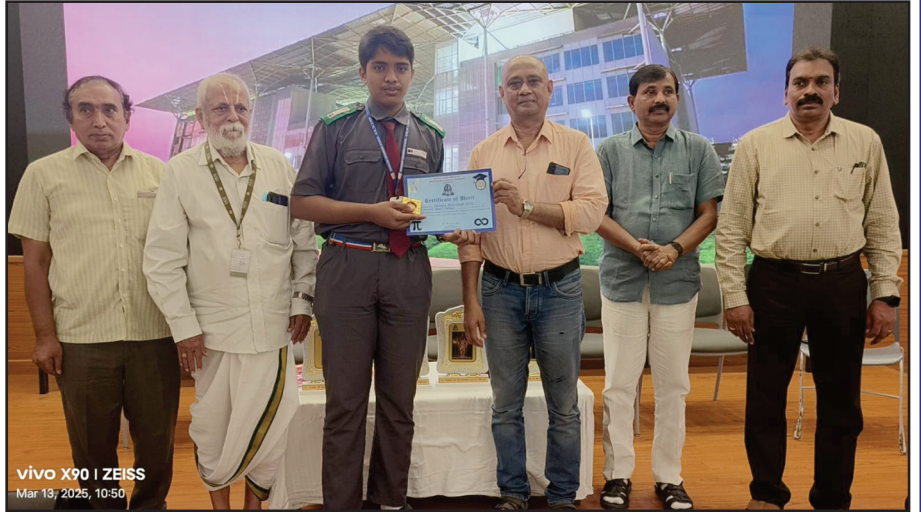
Breaking barriers in Mathematics

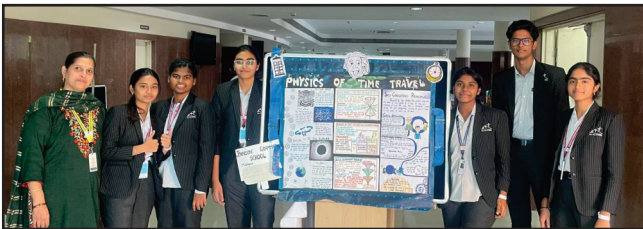

Shining Bright At BITS : A National Science Day To Remember



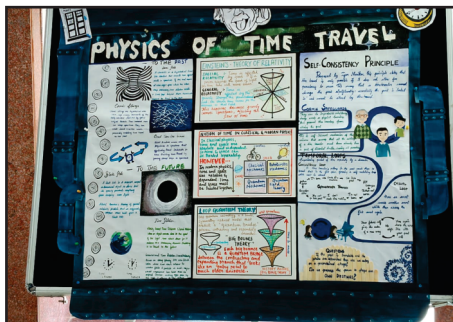

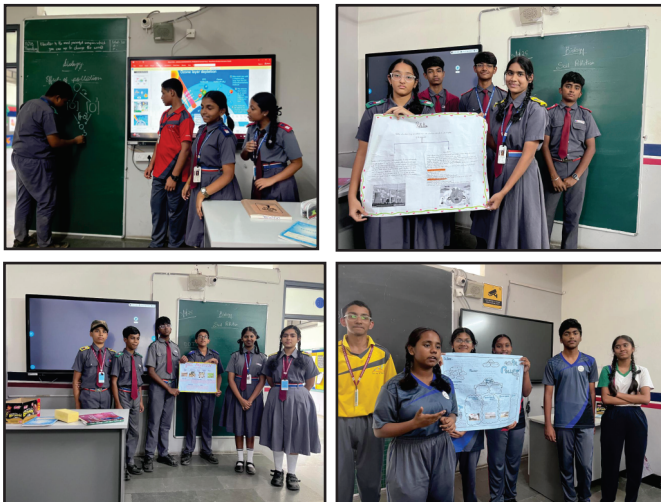
JGS Mallapur Shines Bright on the Literary Stage!
